This information is for Westar Energy’s RENEW: Renewable Energy Program product. RENEW matches your chosen percentage of your electricity usage or is sold in blocks of 100 kilowatt-hours (kWh). In 2017, RENEW, also marketed as Westar Wind, was sourced from the following new renewable resources. Averaged annually, all quantities in percentages above 25% of a customer’s usage is Green-e Energy certified and “meets the environmental and consumer-protection standards set forth by the nonprofit Center for Resource Solutions. Our customer’s support of the RENEW program will help encourage the development of electricity from renewable sources. RENEW is sold as a percentage of your electricity usage (Green-e Energy Certified above 25% of usage) or in blocks of 100 kilowatt-hours (kWh). How will I be billed?	Renewable Energy Charges are in addition to the charges in the Net Monthly Bill section of the applicable Rate Schedule under which customer takes electric service.
How will my bill be calculated?	\$0.25 per 100 kWh Block or \$0.0025 per kWh.
Will my rates change over time	RENEW prices are based on current Kansas Corporation Commission (KCC) approved tariffs. Pricing is subject to change. All price changes require approval from the KCC. Customers will be notified of any price change in advance.
What sources will be used in my certified product?	100% Wind
What length of agreement is requested?	1 year
Will my participation in RENEW continue after the end of the first year?	Yes. Participants are asked to commit to purchasing RENEW for at least one year. The program will automatically renew each billing cycle unless the customer or the Company requests to end the program at least 30 days prior. There are no penalties or cancellation fees associated with customer program cancellation.
What other fees might I be charged?	You must also pay all applicable federal, state, or local taxes.
